Main Idea Use linked data to provide meaningful information about subject headings, and provide avenues for discovery through hierarchical subject connections and enriched context.


## FAST subjects provide the links

#### Limitations

- Not every concept/entity has a Wikidata entry
  - Esp. subdivided headings, compound headings, headings qualified by nationality, ethnic group, or language
- Differences in data modeling
  - Wikidata has separate entries for Asparagus (genus),
  - Asparagus officinalis (species), and Asparagus
  - (vegetable). FAST / LCSH collapses these into one.

#### Name changes

FAST / LCSH separate entries for Michigan State University / Michigan State College.
 Wikidata treats these as aliases of the same entity.



#### Limitations

- Wikipedia: its vastness, inconsistency, lacunae
  - Tertiary source, "needs its own lens of both caution and possibility" -- Anasuya Sengupta, DLF 2018
- Library of Congress: Slowness to change, incompleteness, unfitness for many knowledges.
