Sitzman requires users to adjust to the idiosyncratic arrangement of his essays, chronologies, and bibliographies before finding the important references buried in *African Libraries*; with some attention and skill, this can be done. Because of its comprehensive scope, *African Libraries* is an important guide to the library literature about and from Sub-Saharan Africa that is difficult to identify. However, its arrangement, with some parts already out of date, and its lack of comprehensive indexes prevent it from being an unqualified first-choice reference tool.—John Bruce Howell, International Studies Bibliographer, University of Iowa Libraries, Iowa City.
