During her career, Ragsdale was an active member of the ACRL, the Library Administration and Management Association, Special Libraries Association, Southeastern Library Association, and the Alabama Library Association—serving as an officer when called. Ragsdale was awarded the UA Library Leadership Award for faculty in 2004 and received the Distinguished Alumni Award in 2012 from the UA School of Library and Information Studies. **\*\***
