Welcome to the 5th International Conference on Interdisciplinary Social Sciences. In 2010, the Conference will be held at University of Cambridge, Cambridge, UK from 2-5 August 2010.

The Conference will address interdisciplinary practices across the social sciences, and between the social sciences and the natural sciences, applied sciences and the professions. Plenary speakers will include some of the world's leading thinkers in the social sciences, as well as numerous paper, colloquium and workshop presentations. All Conference participants who have finalised their registration will receive a complimentary online subscription to the Journal. This subscription is valid until one year after the Conference end date.
