IEEE EDUCON 2015 will be hosted by Tallinn University of Technology in the period of 18–20 March. **Tallinn University of Technology** (TUT) is one of the leading technical universities in the region with a strong focus on high-level research in engineering, technology and innovation-related fields. TUT is a modern and internationally successful university, with a long academic history since 1918. TUT is the only campus university in the Baltic region having one of the most compact university campuses in Europe. The territory of TUT includes 55 buildings and has a total area of 55.5 hectares.

Tallinn, the capital of Estonia, is definitely one of the most remarkable cities in the Baltic Sea Region because of its historic riches and future potential, located on the coast of Gulf of Finland. Tallinn is one of the best-retained medieval towns in Europe, with its web of winding cobblestone streets, developed in the 11–15th centuries, preserved in its entirety. The Old Town of Tallinn has been inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List.
