

BOOK REVIEWS

Inleiding tot die interne Geneeskunde: H. P. Wasser-
man (1978). Stellenbosch Universiteitsuitgewers en
Boekhandelaars. 535 bls. Hardeband. Derde uitgawe.

Hierdie teks vul 'n leemte in die opleiding van Afrikaanssprekende fisioterapie studente. Hoewel dit hoofsaaklik vir verpleegsters bedoel is, sal dit 'n uitste-kende inleiding vir paramedici wees.

Die rangskikking van hoofstukke, asook die inhoud van hoofstukke in die volgorde van basiese beginsels, toestande wat algemeen voorkom en seldsame toestande, is handig.

Die boek is van besondere waarde daar dit spesifiek met Suid-Afrikaanse geneeskunde gemoeid is, vandaar die afwesigheid van verwysings na ander skrywe.

Sommige van die toestande sal egter meer breedvoerig deur fisioterapie studente bestudeer moet word en bykomende of verwysing na aanvullende skrywe kan van waarde wees. As teksboek vir inleidende voorgraadse studie is die werk baie gesik.

Die inhoudsopgawe is goed uiteengesit met beson-
derhede oor die verskillende onderafdelings, net jammer dat bladsy aanwysing nie altyd korrek is nie.

"It has been my life's work to devise, and as far as possible to perfect, a method of clinical examination which leads to accurate diagnosis in locomotor disorders, enabling the physician to ignore ubiquitous misleading phenomena of referred pain and referred tenderness". (Author's preface). The physical examination and treatment of the soft tissue structures of the locomotor system are topographically clearly described. Manipulation: medical and lay is discussed.

In addition, this edition of this book already well-known to physiotherapists especially those interested in treating soft tissue problems, includes a review of literature up to the end of 1977 so that researchers can be guided to the original record. Chiropractic is also discussed more fully than in previous editions.

The book is well-presented and would be a valuable addition to the library of medical and physiotherapy training institutions as well as a valuable acquisition to physiotherapists working in this sphere.
