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Rudolph Ng studied history in St. Louis (USA), Heidelberg, and Madrid. Currently, he is pursuing a doctoral degree at St. Catharine's College, Cambridge, where his research interests include global history and migration patterns. His research project examines Spanish coolie trade in Asia in the nineteenth century when the Madrid government, its diplomatic outposts, and a few conglomerates contributed to an international network of human trade spanning Asia, Europe and the Americas. The search for primary sources and secondary literature led him to the story of the Chinese Commission to Cuba, a study of which is the subject of the paper in this issue.

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
