ON THE

#### Revision of the Tables of Lessons

The Joint Commission on the Revision of the Tables of Lessons appointed at the General Convention of 1907

presents the following report:

The Commission organized by the election of the Bishop of Bethlehem as Chairman, and the Reverend Doctor Alfred Harding as Secretary. Sub-Committees were appointed as follows:

On the Lessons for Sundays: The Bishop of Rhode Island, the Reverend Doctor Peabody and Mr. William

C. Sturges, of Colorado.

On the Lessons for Holy Days: The Bishop of Los Angeles, the Reverend J. P. D. Llwyd, and the Hon. Page Morris.

On the Lessons for Special Occasions: The Bishop of Lexington, the Rev. Doctor J. B. Perry, and Mr.

James McConnell.

On the Lessons for Lent: The Bishop-Coadjutor of Albany, the Rev. Doctor Edward A. Larrabee, and Mr. George Wharton Pepper.

On the Lessons for Week Days: The Bishop of Bethlehem, the Reverend Doctor Harding, and Colonel C. M.

Clement.

The Commission has lost by death the Bishop of Rhode Island and the Reverend Dr. J. B. Perry. The Reverend J. P. D. Llwyd resigned on account of removal to Canada. The Bishop of Los Angeles asked to be excused from serving on the Commission and the consideration of a Table of Lessons for Holy Days was referred to the Committee on Lenten Lessons. The Reverend Doctor Harding became Bishop of Washington in 1909, but at the request of the Commission continued to serve as its Secretary.

Shortly after its appointment, the Commission sent a

statement to the Church papers, giving the scope of the work assigned to the Commission and asking that suggestions as to any of the tables be sent to the Bishop on each Sub-Committee. Several meetings of the Commission have been held at which the various memorials and petitions on this subject, presented to the last General Convention, were considered and also the reports of the Sub-Committees.

The memorial on the subject of the permissive use of the Revised Version of the Holy Scriptures, having been referred to this Commission, it was resolved that, inasmuch as this matter was distinct from the revision of the Tables of Lessons, they should submit a separate report

with regard to it.

The general principle which has guided the Commission in its work was that it was to prepare a revision and not make entirely new tables. In general, therefore, its aim has been to shorten the lessons wherever practicable without injury to the sense, and to substitute new Lessons wherever more appropriate ones could be found. This is exemplified in the Revision proposed of

the Table of proper Lessons for Sundays.

The work of the Sub-Committee on these Lessons has been carried on under serious difficulties, owing to the lamented death of the Chairman, the Bishop of Rhode Island, and the absence from this country of another member of the Committee. For these reasons conferences of the Committee during the later months, as its work was approaching completion, have not been possible. Numerous suggested alterations, for which the Sub-Committee desires to express its grateful appreciation, have been carefully considered and many of them adopted.

No change has been made for the sake of change. In this connection the Committee states that it finds that the more it has studied the existing Lectionary, the more it has been impressed with the skill and insight shown by the compilers and the less inclined to suggest alternate lessons for the present table. It has aimed to shorten the lessons, especially in the evenings of the Sundays after Trinity. In the case of the Lessons for the Sundays in the first half of the Church year it has found this was less generally advisable. It has accentuated as far as possible the correspondence between

the first and second Lessons, both Morning and Evening, so far as actual teaching is concerned. This is difficult if the line of historical continuity is to be followed at the same time. The present Lectionary does both very strikingly. It has also adjusted a good many lessons, the beginning or the ending of which seemed unsatisfactory. The desire which has been generally expressed for a larger liberty in the use of the Bible and a more comprehensive survey of the Scriptures, especially those of the Old Testament, has been borne in mind.

The Commission regrets that the proposed table of alternate lessons for Sunday, submitted by the Diocese of California, was not received in time to give it the consideration it merits. It therefore recommends that such

table be given further consideration.

Comparatively few changes have been made in the present Table of Lessons for Holy Days and these do not affect the principal Festivals. Inasmuch as the Lessons for Ash Wednesday and Holy Week are included in the Table of Proper Lessons for the Forty Days of Lent, it has seemed unnecessary to include them in the Table

for Holy Days as our present table does.

In response to several urgent requests that the Commission should prepare a Table of Proper Lessons for the Eves of Holy Days, such a table is included in this report. In its preparation the Commission has had the aid of a distinguished clergyman, who has given to this matter very careful study and consideration. In many of the churches, in which there is a special Saint's Day Service, this service is held on the Eve, and the ordinary Daily Lessons, being the only ones at present appointed, are most inappropriate. It is believed that this table will meet a recognized need.

The Commission has approved the principles on which the Sub-Committee on the revision of the Lessons for Lent acted. Inasmuch as this table shows more extensive changes than any of the others, the following statement

of the committee is made part of this report:

"During the fifth week in Lent, they have tried to lay emphasis upon our Lord's offering of Himself for the sins of the world, and, during Holy Week, they have sought to follow the story of His Passion. Throughout the rest of the sacred season they have directed attention to the Person and teaching of our Lord as set forth in the Gospels; not attempting to compose a harmony, but tracing the story through the successive accounts given by the Evangelists. For these New Testament Lessons they have sought an Old Testament background, believing that in this way the purpose of the Holy Scriptures will be made manifest. They have suggested short readings, in the belief that they will prove to be of greater devotional value.

Your Committee believes that the Lenten season affords an opportunity for exhibiting the Person and teaching of our Lord as a whole, and that attention should be concentrated upon this during the entire season. This will involve the repetition of many passages which will be read at other times in the year, and in some cases a repetition of teachings which will be given in the Holy Gospels for Sundays.

We do not believe that such repetitions are vain, but, on the contrary, that they will emphasize the teachings for those who hear them on Sundays, while supplying the want of those who have lacked this privilege."

The Sub-Committee on the Table of Lessons for Special Occasions, under the guidance of the Chairman, the Bishop of Lexington, sought for expert aid to secure for each of the special occasions requiring place in the Table, the suggestion of proper Lessons by one who had unusual opportunity to learn what would be, not only appropriate, but also especially acceptable to those interested in that particular service. This effort was successful in less than half of the subjoined list of special occasions for which lessons were appointed.

At the suggestion of one of the secretaries of the Board of Missions, who was asked to propose lessons for Missionary Occasions, no differentiation has been made between the several departments of Missions, as Foreign, Domestic, etc. It has been thought wise to propose a number of Lessons for Missionary Services, from which the officiants on such occasions can select those best suited for the special circumstances. Moreover, this whole schedule for Special Occasions and proper lessons has been submitted to a number of clergymen for their

criticism. A word as to the difficulties of the task of preparing such a table is fair. These lie largely in the fact that in most cases only a few verses embrace the portion of a chapter appropriate to a special occasion, and the adoption of a Lesson is embarrassed by the question as to whether or not the context is sufficiently congruous to the occasion. Some of the selections at first sight may seem questionable. The difficulty will be found in getting anything better.

The table proposed expresses what may be considered a maximum of special occasions for which proper lessons

should be provided.

The Sub-Committee on the Table of Lessons for Week Days has aimed to shorten the Lessons, to omit portions deemed unedifying to the general congregation, to make the reading of historical portions of the Old Testament more continuous, and especially so to divide chapters as to bring out clearly all the incidents of the narrative, or the complete thought of the writer on a particular subject. The difficulty of revising these Tables consists in having to provide for the limited number of week days, from which the Holy Days must be subtracted, lessons covering the reading of most of the Old Testament once during the year and the New Testament practically in its entirety twice. There are narratives which are quite too long for any one service, which have had to be divided at as appropriate a place as could be found. There are speeches and prayers of great length, which also have had to be thus divided. The latest Revision of these tables by the Church of England has been consulted as well as the Revised Version, for suggestions in determining the selections.

The Commission hopes that the subjoined tables, representing as they do arduous labor on the part of its members and the best thought that they could give the various problems involved, will meet with the approval of the sober judgment of the Church when they have been sufficiently examined. To this end, they beg to offer the

following resolutions:

(The resolutions are printed in the form as adopted by the concurrent vote of the two houses of the General

Convention.)

Resolved, That the Tables of Lessons be amended by adding thereto as alternates the Tables of Lessons re-

ported to this Convention by the Joint Commission on the Revision of the Tables of Lessons, and that said alternate Lessons be authorized for use in this Church until

the meeting of the next General Convention.

Resolved, That permission be granted that such proposed Lessons, appointed on any day for Morning and Evening Prayer, may be used interchangeably at the discretion of the Minister until the next General Convention.

Resolved, That the Joint Commission on the revision of the tables of lessons be continued to receive suggestions arising from the tentative use of the tables proposed in their report; to consider the proposed table of alternate lessons for Sundays, submitted by the Diocese of California, with a view to determining the fitness thereof and whether or not they should be used collectively in alternate years or individually as alternate lessons, and that this table be printed in the Journal.

Resolved, That the Commission be authorized to prepare a supplementary Table of Old Testament Lessons, following the Hebrew Division of the Law, the Prophets and the Writings, and giving extracts from the books not otherwise appointed for Sundays or Holy Days.

Resolved, That the Joint Commission be authorized to correct all typographical errors in the tables presented

before publishing the same for distribution.
