I thank Thee most heartily, * Fountain of every good for all the benefits I have received from the first instant of my life to this very moment, * and more particularly * for the grace of my preservation, * and for having kept me this night under Thy protection. * O my Creator, * I repent and am heartily sorry for having offended thee * by the many sins by which I have vilified thy Supreme Majesty, * and Infinite Goodness; * I humbly ask pardon for them * and resolve with the help of thy grace * rather to die than to offend Thee again. * I offer Thee, * in union with the Passion and merits of our Lord Jesus Christ, * my every thought, word, and action, * not only of this day, * but of every day of my life, * for thy greater glory, * for the salvation of my soul, * and according to all the intentions I am bound to have, * that I may gain this day all possible indulgences, * that everything may be pleasing in Thy sight, * advantageous to me, * and profitable to all the living and to the dead * who are suffering in Purgatory. * And because without Thee,* O my Hope, my Refuge, and my Strength, * I cannot do anything, * I beseech that Thy grace may predispose, * accompany, and follow me, * so that I may abstain from all evil, * do all the good I can, * and fulfill perfectly thy most holy will in all things. * Most Holy Trinity * have mercy on me; most Holy Virgin, Mother of God, * pray for me; my Guardian Angel protect me, * and my Patron Saint assist me.

One in Three Divine Persons, worthy of all reverence and love! * In the abyss of my nothingness * I humble myself before Thee, * and confess Thy absolute dominion over me. * O my gracious Lord, * would that I had a grateful heart with which to thank thee! * My greatest Treasure and Benefactor, * I thank Thee for the many graces * with which Thou has enriched me this day: * I thank Thee, especially * for having created me in Thy Power, * and for having preserved and protected me in Thy Providence: * I thank Thee for the gift of Faith, * for the grace of repentance, * for the benefit of Thy Sacraments, * thru which, as I firmly hope, * I have been restored to Thy favor; * I thank Thee for the light * that Thou hast vouchsafed to me this day, * and in the past, that I might know Thy ways, and walk securely in them, * and thus one day * attain to the eternal possession of Thy sweet Self; * I thank Thee, lastly for the numberless other graces * which Thou has conferred on me, * and of which I am ignorant. * O Supreme Good; * would that I could heartily and adequately repay Thee * for Thy many gifts to me * Father of mercies and Light of my soul, * grant me now the further grace * to know the sins I have today committed, * in thought, word, deed, or omission: * likewise awaken in me a true sorrow, * and detestation for them, * and help me to make firm resolution of amendment.

I am sorry and grieved for having so offended Thee, * since Thou deservest to be infinitely loved, served, and obeyed. * Would that I could die of pure sorrow for having offended Thee, * or satisfy in some way for the injury I have done Thee * Now I propose to offend Thee no more, * to shun all occasions of sin, * and to keep faithfully Thy most holy law. * My Lord Jesus Christ, * forgive this heart for its ungratefulness. * It is a humble and contrite heart * and longs to love Thee without reserve; * it desires but to pulsate in Thy sacred side, * and therein to live and die. * May the most Blessed Virgin Mary, * and all the angels and my patron saint * assist me during this night * and deliver me from a sudden death * and obtain from the Divine Majesty my eternal salvation! O my dear Mother, * rest upon my head the loving hand of Thy most dear Son. *

May the most Holy Trinity * and Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament * be ever praised, loved and glorified! * Blessed be the holy and Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary! * Jesus, Mary, and Joseph I give you my heart, my soul and my life; * Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, * assist me now and in my last agony: * Jesus, Mary and Joseph, * may I die in peace in your holy company!
