

How to Serve Mass and Pronounce the Latin

Priest.—Introibo ad altare Dei.

Server.—Ad Day-um quee lay-tif-ee-cat | ju-
ven-too-tem may-am.

Priest.—Judica me, Deus, et discerne causam

When the priest turns round and says:

Orate fratres.

Server answers:

Day-oh-grah-tsias.
