FOREWORD

CORRUPTIONS OF CHRISTIAN NAMES was published as an inexpensive pamphlet in 1910. The compiler, Reverend Francis Mershman, a monk of this abbey, passed away in 1916. Little attention was given to the pamphlet after his death. It had been practically forgotten until the reorganization of the publishing department of the Abbey Press brought to light a goodly number of copies that had been stored away. In some way knowledge of the existence of this compilation has spread; requests for it have multiplied to such an extent that it has been thought advisable to give it a new printing.

Its purpose is not the presentation of a complete list of Christian names. There are such collections in existence: Holweck's BIOGRAPHICAL DICTIONARY OF THE SAINTS; THE BOOK OF THE SAINTS, by the Monks of Ramsgate, and others, especially Weidenhan, BAPTISMAL NAMES. This pamphlet is merely an attempt to supplement these works by giving a list of "corruptions" of Christian names—or, perhaps better,—of other than the standard form of these Christian names.

The forms here presented do not, by any means, exhaust the list. New forms, at least as far as the spelling of the names goes, are generated almost daily, especially in female names. Those listed herein present only the traditional forms used in English, together with some forms occasionally used by English-speaking peoples or met with in English literature; for instance, Ivan, Juan, Stanek. In the first edition of this pamphlet there were a great many corruptions or abbreviations of German baptismal names. These have practically gone out of existence in this country and hence have, for the most part, been omitted. Besides what has just been said, we beg the reader to bear in mind what follows that he may have a better understanding of the contents and purpose of this compilation.

1. Some diminutives, or pet names, have been listed that have acquired a standard form and are hardly recognized nowadays as diminutives; for instance, Franklin, diminutive of Francis; St. Francis would be the namesake of the child called Franklin. The same would hold for Evelyn, as a diminutive for Eve, and for many others.

2. There are in the list also some foreign language forms, since they connote a saint who has become familiar, because a town bears

his name: as St. Vaast (Vedastus), St. Cloud (Clodoaldus), St. Die (Deodatus).

3. Some diminutives are mentioned because they differ so much from the original form that their derivation is not easily recognizable; for instance, Flossie from Florentia and Flora.

4. In a few instances names not well known, nor frequently found, but of recognized saints are listed; for instance, Fridolin; or found almost exclusively among non-English people in this country; such as, Tillman, Ferruccio. Also abbreviated forms; such as Greg(g) for Gregory, Ward for Edward.

5. Variant feminine forms have been given separately from the masculine. Where the masculine alone of the Latin form of the name is given it means that there is no recognized female saint of that name; for instance, Raymundus for Ramona; Anselmus for Selma. The bearer of such a name should venerate the male saint as patron.

6. An abbreviated form is sometimes the same as the unabbreviated name of one who is listed as a saint; thus Thea is an abbreviated form of Dorothea; but there is also a Saint Thea. The priest baptizing should make inquiry at baptism which of the two names it is desired to impose on the child.

7. Some abbreviated Christian names have passed into family names and are sometimes imposed in baptism; for instance, Mason is an abbreviated form of Matthewson; Benson for Benedictson; Nelson for Corneliusson. As surnames, when they came into use, were frequently nothing but the indication of the filial relationship between the bearer and the father known by his baptismal name, the saint to whose name the suffix 'son' has been added is the patron saint of the child. Some surnames are the names of men and women whose sanctity has been officially recognized by the Church; for instance, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Aloysius Gonzaga; St. Francis Xavier, St. Francis de Sales. Aquinas, Gonzaga, Xavier, Sales and others have been accepted names in baptism or in religious profession, with the understanding that the patron is St. Francis Xavier, etc. So, too, may such names as More, Howard, Maxfield and others be assumed in baptism or religious profession in pious memory of St. Thomas More, Bl. William Howard, Bl. Thomas Maxfield. We give a partial list of these martyrs of the Reformation Period: names whose form and sound seemed to us the more likely to meet with the favor of parents seeking more modern saints' names. We do not recommend imposition of a name in baptism which is not easily recognized as the name of a saint. But, since some of our Catholic people insist on the imposition of such names, we have thought it expedient to list those which, in virtue of brevity and sound, are more likely to be selected.

8. No attempt has been made to give all possible Latin equivalents for the abbreviated name-forms listed in this pamphlet. Thus, Hilda may be an abbreviation of Hildegardis, Hildegundis, Hiltrudis, and others. We have thought it sufficient to give the Latin form of the name of at least one servant of God who has received veneration in the Church. However, some exceptions have been made.

One of the above-mentioned books, to which may be added Hoffmann, BENEDICTINE MARTYROLOGY; Smith, BAPTISMAL AND CONFIRMATION NAMES; Yonge, CHRISTIAN NAMES (also ROMANCE OF NAMES); Nied, NAMENGEbung, ought to be in the library of every pastor. There are not a few rather uncommon Christian names which have undergone no variation; for instance, Conan, Darius, Ewald, Finian. These will, therefore, not be found in our list. To reject them for this reason as not Christian would be a mistake.

The study of names and of the changes they have undergone is a fascinating one. While a number of books deal with this question, there seems to be none that is entirely satisfactory. Nor does it appear that there will ever be perfect agreement as to the derivation of some names.
